

Date	Location	Event
30/10/18	Wilhelmshaven	Some sailors refuse to obey orders. The fleet is sent to Kiel and 47 are imprisoned
01/11/18	Kiel	Sailors and workers meet at the Trade Union HQ to discuss how to get the rebellious sailors released
02/11/18	Kiel	Workers and sailors meet at the parade grounds to protest
03/11/18	Kiel	Larger protests involving many townspeople. Shots are fired and 7 men are killed
04/11/18	Kiel	Protests at naval barracks. First councils are set up. 14 points are published
05/11/18	Germany	Delegations of sailors and workers are dispatched across Germany
07/11/18	Munich	The monarchy flee and so Kurt Eisner declares Bavaria to be a free state
09/11/18	Germany	Kaiser abdicates. Germany's ruling monarchic families flee
10/11/18	Berlin	Elections to workers' and soldiers' councils held
11/11/18	Germany	Armistice signed
15/11/18	Bremen	Bremen declares itself to be a republic
16/12/18	Berlin	A congress for all the councils across Germany is called. This gathering in Berlin is met with violence. Several people are killed
19/12/18	Berlin	Councils vote to hold elections (which is what Ebert wanted). This and disputes over pay lead to violence over the Christmas period
31/12/18	Berlin	Rosa Luxemburg draws up the founding documents for the communist party (KPD)
05/01/19	Berlin	"Spartakist Uprising" Spartakist, KPD and USPD call for a mass demonstration to fulfil the aims of the November Revolution. Take over bourgeois newspaper HQs

07/01/19	Berlin	Spartakists call for a General Strike and thousands of workers take to the streets
08/01/19	Berlin	Ebert called in to negotiate. Concerns that he is using the Freikorps to crush the revolution. Talks disintegrate. Violence on the streets
11/01/19	Berlin	Government troops mobilise against the revolutionaries occupying the SPD newspaper publishing house. The revolutionaries attempt to negotiate a surrender. They are either beaten to death or shot.
15/01/19	Berlin	Liebknecht and Luxemburg arrested and murdered
19/01/19	Berlin	Constituent National Assembly elected. SPD gains majority
21/02/19	Munich	Kurt Eisner and the USPD defeated in elections. He is about to announce his resignation when he is shot dead. Socialist revolutionaries then shoot SPD leader Auer (he survived)
04/03/19	Berlin	General strike called to fulfil aims of November Revolution
08/03/19	Berlin	Noske says Berlin is under siege. Freikorps soldiers begin to take positions. Street battles last until 13/14 March. About 1200 people are killed
09/03/19	Berlin	Noske allows government soldiers to execute suspects on the spot
07/04/19	Munich	Bavaria proclaimed to be a Soviet Republic. The government flees and the councils set up their own courts and Red Guards. Ernst Toller, Gustav Landauer are in charge
13/04/19	Munich	Government attempts to take Munich back. Communist party seize control under Max Levien and Eugen Levine.
16/04/19	Munich	Ernst Toller leads a group of Red Guards to victory against the government White Guards

		near Dachau. Government calls for national support
29/04/19	Munich	Government soldiers execute prisoners, Russian POWs
30/04/19	Munich	Red Guard execute nine hostages at a school (Luitpoldgymnasium). Countess Hella von Westarp is the only woman killed
01/05/19	Munich	Government forces storm the city. Street battles
02/05/19	Munich	Gustav Landauer arrested and kicked to death
03/05/19	Munich	Republic declared to be over
05/06/19	Munich	Eugen Levine executed after trial
